- The focus for this academic school year is on explicit instruction and discussion to build comprehension skills and writing.
- A Partner's Program will be established during this school year to assure that all stakeholders are involved in the academic growth of the students at FCS.

- Data-The school has been taking their BOY assessment through the use of MAP and vertical assessments. These assessments will identify strands of standards that students are deficient.

- A social emotional center is set up in every classroom so students can de-escalate or take a moment of reflection before joining the class environment.
